I am happy to inform you that the student is improving daily but still remains in the hospital. The doctors believe that the student will make a full recovery but it will be a process. I would ask that you please keep the student and the family in your prayers. We hope that the student will be able to come home by Christmas.

Prior to the student's reentry to Scottsboro Junior High, the student will be medically cleared by the doctors. We are still in contact with the Madison County Health Department and the Immunization Compliance Manager/Team Member in charge of this case, Mr. Ronnie Darrington.
